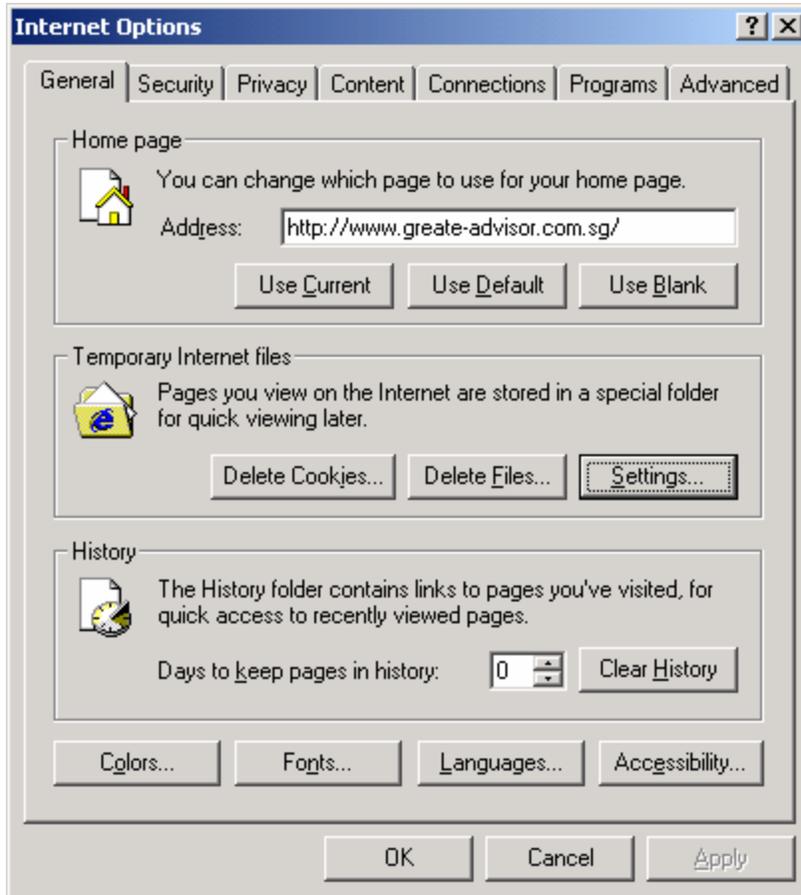


How To Configure Browser For Proxy (Internet Explorer)

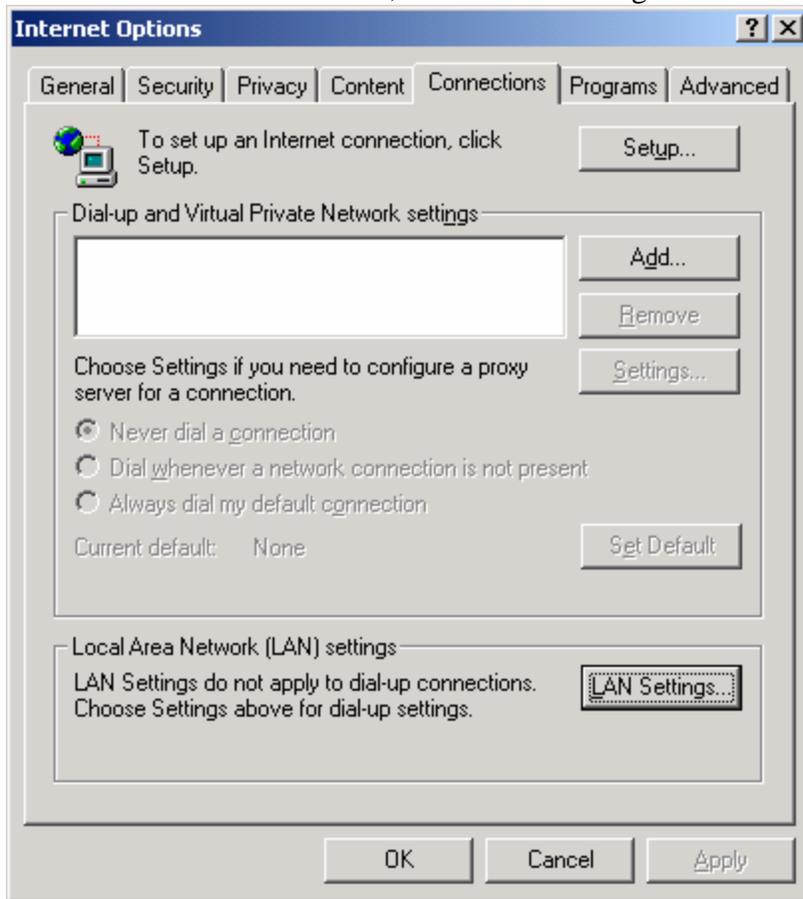
This document shows how to configure your browser to access internet with the implementation of the proxy server. **If there are already some settings, kindly copy the details so that you can switch back later when you are in different network – for example, your personal broadband at home.**

1. Launch your browser, click on “Tools” and “Internet Options”. The following will be shown:

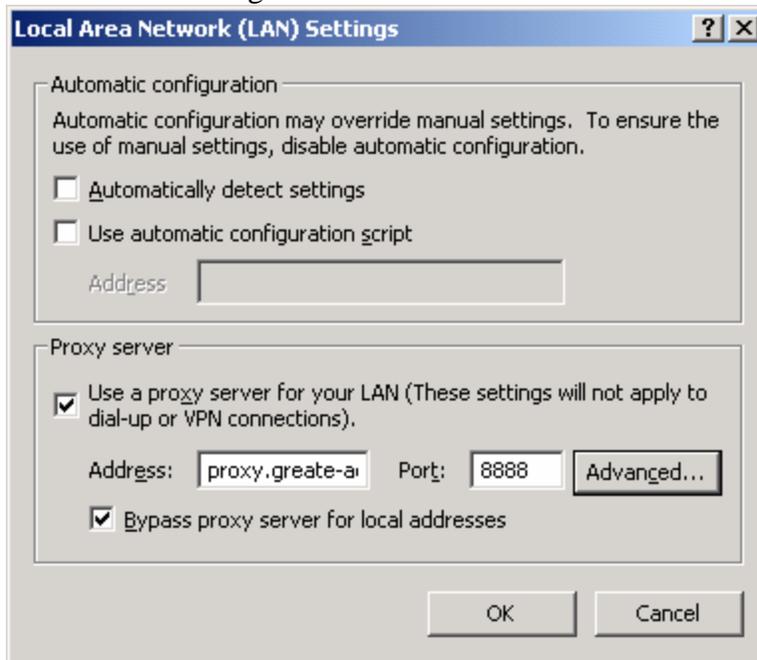


Note that your homepage address may be different.

2. Click on “Connections” tab, then “LAN Settings” button.



3. Ensure the settings are the same as follow:

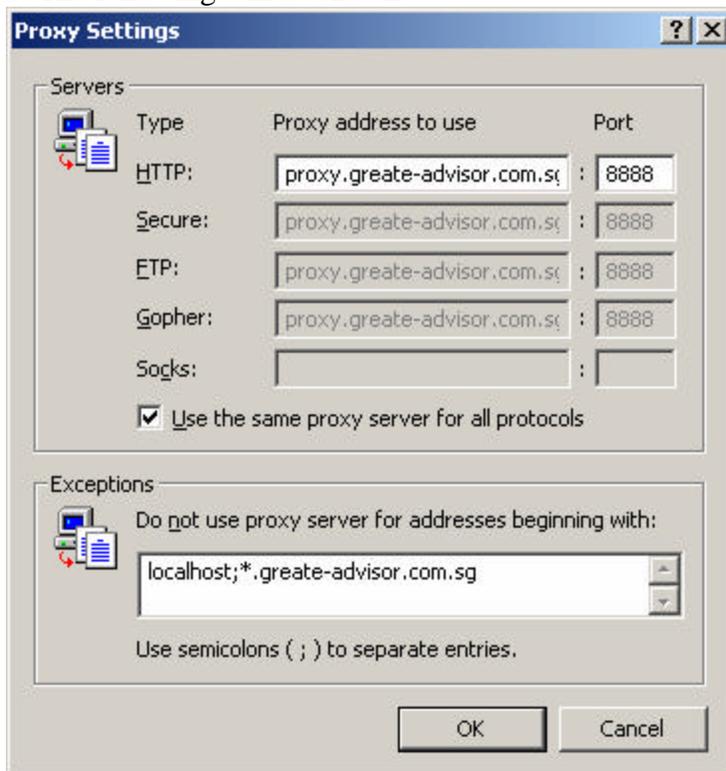


Check the option box as shown above.

Enter "proxy.greate-advisor.com.sg" without quotes in the "Address" text box and "Port" number as 8888.

4. Click on the "Advanced..." button.

5. The following will be shown:



In the “HTTP” text box, enter “proxy.greate-advisor.com.sg” without quotes and “Port” as 8888 as shown above (it may already be completed, if so, ensure it’s the same as you entered in step 3)

Check the “Use the same proxy server for all protocols” box. The “Secure”, “FTP”, “Gopher” text boxes will be automatically be filled with text and grey out. The “Socks” text box will be grey out also.

In the “Exceptions” text box, enter the wordings “localhost;*.greate-advisor.com.sg” without quotes.

6. Click “Okay” button a few times to return to your browser.

7. Close your browser. Then re-launch your browser.

8. Now when you visit external websites, a prompt will appear as shown:



Enter your proxy id and password and click “Okay”. The website you are visiting will then show up. Note that you may need to press the “F5” key to refresh the page.

Note that id and password are case-sensitive.
